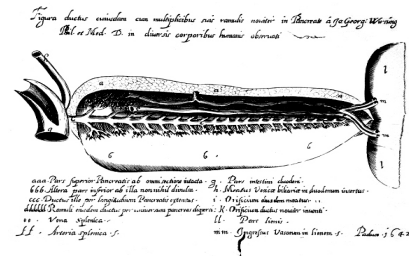

Call for Abstracts

We invite you to submit your best and most current work, either from your clinical or laboratory research. Oral presentations are scheduled for 10 minutes with 5 minutes allotted for discussion. There will again be short oral/poster presentations of 3 minutes with 2 minutes for discussion. These shorter presentations may be used as an introduction to data which can be more fully described in a poster. During daily breaks, selected posters will be highlighted and there will be daily poster-side Professor Rounds. *William Nealon, MD, Program Chair*

Seminal Research Reports: If you have a paper already published since the last Pancreas Club meeting (May 30 & 31, 2009) and which reflects the highest level of evidence, it may be submitted under the category of "Seminal Research." Selected authors will be invited to present this work for discussion by the attendees.

PLEASE NOTE: THIS DEADLINE IS CONSIDERABLY EARLIER THAN PREVIOUS YEARS.

Awards: The Pancreas Club is pleased to announce two awards that began in 2009. The program committee will rate each oral presentation and the award recipients will be announced at the Sunday dinner event.

- **PanCan Research Award.** \$1,000 for the best oral presentation of clinical or basic science pancreatic cancer research by a resident or fellow. This award is funded by the Pancreatic Cancer Action Network
- **Kenneth Warren Research Award.** \$1,000 for the best oral presentation of clinical or basic science pancreatitis or pancreatic cancer research by a resident or fellow. This award is funded by the Pancreas Club and the Kenneth Warren Foundation

Residents and Fellows. In order to be eligible for either of these two awards, the work must be authored primarily by a resident or fellow and the presentation must be made by the resident or fellow. Presentation of the work by an attending faculty will not be considered for awards.

Abstract format: Each abstract should be constructed as follows:

Title: All upper case

Authors: List each author with corresponding affiliation; see example below:

Font: Times Roman or Arial

Point: 10 or 12 point; SINGLE spaced

Word count: 500 without figure/table/graphic or 300 with one figure/table/graphic; count does not include title or author/affiliation listing

Authors will also be asked to:

Complete financial disclosure information reflecting information on ALL authors

Select the most appropriate category

Pancreatitis – clinical

Pancreatitis – basic science

Pancreatic Cancer – clinical

Pancreatic Cancer – basic science

Identify if the main author is a resident or fellow (thus eligible for one of the awards)

Notice and Registration: Corresponding and senior authors will be notified of acceptance and presentation type by March 1, 2010. Presenting author must register for the meeting.

Oral Presentations: All oral presentations (both 10 minute and 3 minute) must be prepared in PowerPoint. Standard audiovisual equipment will consist of one LCD projector and a central laptop. Presenters will be required to bring their PowerPoint presentation to the meeting on a thumb drive or CD.

Poster Presentations: Poster boards are 4' H x 8' W . Tacks will be provided. Accepted poster authors will be advised of set-up and take down schedule in their notice of acceptance.
